## Eligibility Requirements

Eligibility is based exclusively on academic qualifications. An individual is eligible to take the examination if he/she has:

A bachelor's, master's, or doctoral degree from an accredited institution of higher education;  
AND one of the following:

An official transcript that clearly shows a major in Health Education; Community Health Education; Public Health Education; School Health Education,

OR

An official transcript that reflects 25 semester hours (37 quarter hours) of course work with specific preparation addressing the following seven (7) areas of responsibility:

1. Assess Needs, Assets and Capacity for Health Education/Promotion
2. Plan Health Education/Promotion
3. Implement Health Education/Promotion
4. Conduct Evaluation and Research Related to Health Education/Promotion
5. Administer and Manage Health Education/Promotion

6. Serve as a Health Education/Promotion Resource Person
7. Communicate, Promote and Advocate for Health and the Profession of Health Education/Promotion

### 90-Day Option

This option is offered to students who will be graduating within 90 days of the CHES® exam. The student must submit an official transcript showing a minimum of 25 semester hours relating to the seven areas of responsibility and written verification from an advisor confirming completion of all degree requirements within 90 days of the examination date.
